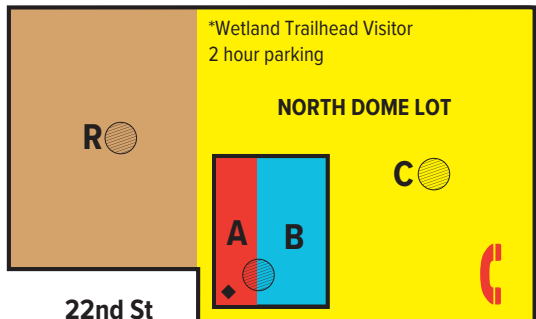




Some streets and lots may be closed for construction beyond what is noted.



Access from the Towers Lot to Hudson Road and the North Dome Lot is available via 18th Street. There is no left turn onto Hudson Road from 19th Street.

Do not park on any city street contrary to posted signage.

Parking Legend

The use of UNI parking facilities, except metered areas, requires registration and parking permit at all times.

G parking
Parking permitted from 7 a.m. to 1 a.m.

A parking
Parking permitted from 7 a.m. to 1 a.m.

B parking
Parking permitted from 7 a.m. to 1 a.m.

C parking
24 hour parking permitted

C Preferred - parking
24 hour parking permitted. Exception: Move in week (week before beginning of the Fall Semester) **NO OVERNIGHT PARKING & MAX TIME LIMIT.**

R parking
24 hour parking permitted. **R permit not valid in C or CP lots**

Metered Lots

D parking
For use by those with a valid handicapped permit or a temporary UNI handicapped permit and valid UNI parking permit

Lot used for scheduled UNI home football games paid parking. Vehicles with current UNI parking permits may be required to pay posted rates.

Other areas as posted. **No overnight parking 1 a.m. to 7 a.m.**

Loading zone
All permit holders may use for specified time period

Service area
May be used by university vehicles and vehicles with service permits

Motorcycle parking
Motorcycles are required to display a valid MC permit and must be parked in motorcycle areas

Accessible Parking
Valid handicapped permit or a temporary UNI handicapped permit and valid UNI parking permit required.

APPROVED LOTS FOR OVERNIGHT PARKING DURING MOVE-IN:

North Dome Lot - C & R (be careful not to park in the designated A/B area)

West Dome Lot - B (south end only)

ITC West Lot - B

27th Street Lot - R

South Art Lot - C

Roth Lot - C (with valid permit)

Jennings Dr. Lot - C (with valid permit)

All other lots are restricted and do not allow for overnight parking.

Parking in lots adjacent to the dorms (CP) is restricted to a max time limit as posted from 8/19-8/23. No overnight parking in these lots until 8/24.

Building numberings begin at the north end of campus and continue to the south.
